- * Arrive Incheon. Transfer to Seoul
 - * Check in to IBIS Myeongdong (3 nights)

Day 3

Included: Breakfast, Lunch

- * Gyeongbokgung Palace - Enjoy the Royal Changing of the Guard Ceremony
 - * Insadong Antique Street - Visit the focal point of Korean traditional culture and crafts
 - * Bukchon Hanok Village - UNESCO-awarded heritage site (home to over 900 traditional Korean houses)
 - * Samcheong-dong - Where tradition meets modern day
 - * Lotte Mart - Most iconic marketplace

Day 4

Included: Breakfast, Lunch

- * Tour of Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) separating North and South Korea
- * Cheonggyecheon Stream - 11 km-long stream that runs through downtown Seoul
- * Gwangjang Market - Best place to savor authentic Korean street food

- * Seoul Tower - The 1st multipurpose tower in Korea, effectively incorporating a sightseeing observatory to a broadcasting tower
- * National Museum of Korea - Dive in the flagship museum of local history and art

- * Transfer to Gimpo airport and fly to Jeju Island
 - * Arrive Jeju Airport
 - * Hallim Park - Variety of gardens that holds monthly flower-related events
 - * Hyeopjae Beach - Enjoy the beautiful scenery view
 - * Check in to Jeju Hotel (2 nights)

- * Sangumburi Crater - A Natural Monument
 - * Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak - A tuff cone formed by volcanic eruptions
 - * Cheonjiyeon Falls - Named "The Pond of God"
 - * Oedolgae Rock - Known as Grandma Rock
 - * If time allows, bonus to traditional 5day Market

- * Yongduam - A Dragon Head Rock created by strong winds and waves over thousands of years
 - * Transfer to Jeju airport to fly to Seoul
 - * Arrive Gimpo airport. Transfer to hotel
 - * Check in to IBIS Myeongdong (2 nights)

- * Transfer to Chuncheon
 - * Nami Island - Enjoy famous BBQ Chicken lunch
