Day 1 - Wednesday, Feb 18, 2026

Depart Honolulu on Japan Airlines 73

HND-OKA(Naha Airport)-Naha

Hotel Collective (Free Wi-Fi)

→ **3:55pm - Arrive at Haneda Airport.** Meet your English speaking assistant at the arrival lobby.

→ **8:00pm - Depart Haneda to Naha on Japan Airlines (JL 925).**

→ Welcome to Naha, the capital of the Okinawa Prefecture and the gateway to exploring the scenic beauty and distinctive culture of the Okinawa islands.

→ **10:50pm** - Upon arrival at Naha, meet your local English speaking guide at the arrival lobby. We'll transfer to **Hotel Collective**, our accommodations for our 5-night stay. Our hotel is just a short walk from Kokusai Dori, Okinawa's shopping district filled with stalls, boutiques & eateries.

Day 3 - Friday, Feb 20, 2026

Naha-Southern Okinawa/Nanjo-Naha

Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Hotel Collective (Free Wi-Fi)

→ **10:00am** - Meet your guide at the hotel lobby.

→ **10:45am** - This morning, visit Nanjo's iconic **Okinawa World**. Visitors are treated to the incredible 3,000 year old natural limestone Gyokusendo Caves; a reconstructed replica of a Ryukyu village with workshops featuring traditional arts and crafts; and a snake themed section dedicated to the infamous local Habu snake. We'll also catch the **Super Eisa Show**, which features traditional Okinawan Eisa dancing and drumming, and the **Habu Snake Show**, a small theater snake demonstration.

→ **1:00pm** - Enjoy **lunch** at a local restaurant.

→ **2:45pm** - Now, we'll visit **Himeyuri no Tou** and **Himeyuri Peace Museum**, prominent and culturally significant Okinawan landmarks honoring the valiant group of high school girls and teachers who were drafted to serve as nurses during WWII.

→ **4:30pm** - Return to hotel. Enjoy an evening of shopping and dining on your own.

Naha-Northern Okinawa/Kunigami-Naha

- **8:00am** - Meet your guide at the hotel lobby.
 - **9:45am** - Now a visit to what has been widely considered the biggest and best aquarium in the world: **Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium**. Initially built for the Okinawa International Ocean Expo in 1975, the aquarium features an impressive 740 species of sea creatures and tanks so large that even enormous whale sharks can be seen on full display.
 - **12:45pm** - Enjoy a **Japanese-style lunch** at a local restaurant.
 - **3:00pm** - This afternoon, we'll make a trip to Nago-based **Helios Awamori Distillery**, a facility that utilizes the high-quality water and natural resources of northern Okinawa to manufacture distinctive products.
 - **5:15pm** - **Arrive at Kencho-mae station area**. We'll walk about 10-min back to the hotel. On our way, our guide will show us the Mikishi Market and Kencho-mae area, highlighting the local culture and cuisine.

 - **10:50am** - Arrive at Ishigaki Island, a destination known for its tropical beauty, serene beaches, and vibrant culture.
 - **12:00pm** - Visit the renowned **Yoneko-yaki Pottery**, a cultural landmark that features a whimsical garden peppered with vibrant Shisa guardian inspired sculptures, a pottery store, and an outdoor studio.
 - **1:00pm** - Enjoy **lunch** at a local restaurant.
 - **2:30pm** - Explore the crystal-clear waters of **Kabira Bay** on a **glass-bottom boat** and marvel at the vibrant marine life and stunning coral reefs beneath you.
 - **3:45pm** - From here, discover the beauty of Okinawa's pearls at the **Ryukyu Pearl shop**. Fun fact: black pearls were first discovered in Kabira Bay, and Ryukyu Pearl pioneered a method to successfully cultivate them!
 - **5:00pm** - Arrive at hotel, followed by a **buffet dinner** at 7:30pm.

Ishigaki-Taketomi-Ishigaki

Included: Breakfast, Dinner

Fusaki Beach Resort Hotel & Villas (Free Wi-Fi)

- **9:30am** - Meet your guide at the hotel lobby.
 - **10:00am** - This morning we'll visit **Mineya Kobo Workshop**, home to a beautiful collection of traditional hand-woven textiles unique to the region. Let's get ready for an exciting **hands-on activity**!
 - **11:30am** - Next, we'll head to the bustling **Ishigaki Kousetsu Ichiba Market**, a vibrant hub of local culture and flavors. Peruse the many stalls offering an array of fresh produce, seafood, and local delicacies and enjoy lunch on your own.
 - **2:00pm** - After lunch, we'll board a **ferry** for a scenic 10-minute ride to **Taketomi Island**, a paradise known for its well-preserved Ryukyu architecture and stunning natural beauty.
 - Upon arrival, we'll hop onto a traditional **buffalo cart** for a leisurely **ride** through the island's picturesque landscapes.
 - After the cart ride, take a **relaxing stroll** along the sandy streets lined with traditional Okinawan houses, complete with red-tiled roofs. Admire the beautiful hibiscus flowers and unique stone walls that characterize the island.
 - **4:50pm** - Take the **ferry** back to Ishigaki Island.
 - **5:05pm** - Following our arrival, enjoy a **Japanese dinner** with **Sanshin Performance** (a show featuring a traditional Okinawan string instrument).
 - **7:45pm** - Return to hotel.
