Itinerary

Day 1: (Wed) Dec 23 – Honolulu Depart Honolulu

→ Meet the Panda Travel representative at the airline's check-in counters 3 hours prior to departure.

Day 2: (Thu) Dec 24 – Haneda-Maihama

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Arrive at Haneda Airport. Meet your English speaking local guide at the arrival lobby before transferring to the hotel.

→ Welcome to **Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama**, the official Tokyo Disney Resort® Hotel! Take advantage of the hotel's direct access to the Disney Resort Line monorail system. The monorail, which loops around the perimeter of the resort, will make several stops, including at the doorsteps of Tokyo Disneyland and DisneySea. If you'd like to explore **Ikspiari**—a vibrant shopping, dining, and entertainment hub—please let your local guide know and they will assist you.

Day 3: (Fri) Dec 25 – Maihama/Tokyo Disneyland (B)

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 8:15am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for the monorail ride to Tokyo Disneyland.

→ Get ready for an exhilarating day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Explore the many Tokyo Disneyland exclusive attractions like its glass covered Victorian-style indoor World Bazaar and the Beauty and the Beast mini-land that stretches from Belle's village square to Beast's Castle. Don't miss out on the spectacular PhilharMagic show and new rides like The Happy Ride with Baymax! In between attractions, snack on a chewy Stormtrooper mochi or hot, fresh popcorn featuring flavors like curry, cookie cream, and garlic shrimp. Enjoy making fun memories today!

→ **Return to hotel** – The monorail will transport you back to the hotel when you decide to return and rest up for the next day's Disney adventure.

Day 4: (Sat) Dec 26 – Maihama/Tokyo DisneySea (B)

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ The day is yours at **Tokyo DisneySea**, the 4th most visited theme park in the world! Excitingly, you'll step foot in the park's newly opened Northern European inspired expansion: Fantasy Springs. With rides, attractions, and foods from the

massively popular Frozen, Tangled, and Peter Pan movies, you'll find Arendelle Castle in Frozen Kingdom, the floating lantern festival in Rapunzel's Forest, a pirate ship in Peter Pan's Neverland, and more! But the fun doesn't end there... drift along the Mediterranean Harbor on a Venetian gondola, descend to the ocean's depths in the 20,000 Leagues Under the Sea submarine, explore caverns of mystery in a subterranean vehicle on the Journey to the Center of the Earth ride, and navigate a watercraft in Aquatopia. Fuel up with a gyoza dog, a tiramisu ice cream sandwich, or a tempura assortment plate. Have fun - Sea you later!

Day 5: (Sun) Dec 27 – Maihama-Chiba-Tokyo (B)

Sunshine City Prince Hotel (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 8:45am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for Chiba.

→ 10:00am – This morning, enjoy a unique hands-on **Sawara paper-mache painting experience**. Have fun creating this personalized memento to take home!

→ 11:00am – Begin a leisurely stroll through **Sawara's historic district**, nicknamed Little Edo. Wander along the preserved merchant streets, warehouses, and scenic Ono River canals once used by traders (1603-1868). The town also hosts the Sawara Grand Festival in July and October.

→ 1:00pm – Our next visit: **Aeon Mall Makuhari/Costco**, one of the largest Aeon Malls in Japan! This enormous complex is divided into 4 themed zones—the Active Mall (sports shops and a sports theme park), Family Mall (toys and play areas), Pet Mall (pet essentials), and the Grand Mall (supermarket, fashion, cinema)—and includes multiple variety stores such as two Daiso shops and a 300-yen store. Spend the afternoon browsing shops, enjoying food court options, and picking up gifts, snacks, or essentials.

→ 4:30pm – Arrive at **Sunshine City Prince Hotel**, where we'll be staying for the remainder of our tour. Our hotel is directly connected to Sunshine City shopping center with many shopping and dining options available to you. During your stay, don't miss the Sunshine Aquarium for an up-close look at marine life or the observatory deck for breathtaking views of Tokyo. The complex also houses a planetarium and an indoor theme park, Namjatown. And nearby, you'll find a 24-hr Family Mart convenience store and a Seiyu supermarket for snack, bento, and beverage pickups. The evening is yours to relax and explore Ikebukuro at leisure.

Day 6: (Mon) Dec 28 – Tokyo (B)

Sunshine City Prince Hotel (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 9:30am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for Tokyo.

→ 10:00am – Start the day at **Tsukiji Outer Market**, a renowned bucket list spot for its fresh seafood and vibrant street food scene. While the inner auction market relocated to Toyosu in 2018, the charm remains in its outer market. Be sure to enjoy all that the outer market has to offer, from seasonal produce and candy tasting to knife-making artisan shops.

→ 12:30pm – From here, head to the bustling shopping streets in the **Asakusa** district. Discover this shopper's paradise, which includes stalls selling local snacks, restaurants, shopping centers, and a colossal 24-hour 7-story Don Quijote.

→ 2:30pm – Are you ready for an exciting **Taiko drum experience**? Learn about Taiko and take part in a hands-on drumming activity that highlights this ancient art form.

→ 4:30pm – Arrive at the **Tokyo Dome City**, an entertainment complex featuring thrilling amusement park attractions and the iconic Tokyo Dome, home field of the Yomiuri Giants baseball team. You may also find yourself indulging in a variety of shopping and dining options. As night falls, prepare to be dazzled by the Winter Illumination, a must-see attraction with stunning lights and fun displays of holiday cheer.

→ 7:00pm – Return to hotel.

Day 7: (Tue) Dec 29 – Tokyo/Free day at leisure (B)

→ After breakfast, enjoy your free day to explore Tokyo!

Day 8: (Wed) Dec 30 – Tokyo/Free day at leisure (B)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 10:00am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for Yokohama.

→ 10:45am – Our day begins at **Kawasaki Daishi Temple**. Founded in 1128, this tranquil sanctuary is dedicated to the revered deity Kobo Daishi, a pivotal figure in Japanese Buddhism known to ward off evil. The temple features a rich history, exquisite architecture, and a serene ambiance. Later, stroll through the nearby shopping streets to explore traditional snacks and souvenirs.

→ 12:30pm – Established in 1859, **Yokohama Chinatown** is the largest Chinatown in Japan. This bustling neighborhood is a culturally rich destination that offers something for everyone. Whether you're indulging in delicious cuisine, exploring historical sites, or shopping for unique souvenirs, you can count on having an unforgettable experience here.

→ 2:30pm – Then, on to **Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse**, a historic shipping hub repurposed into a popular and energetic community entertainment center. Have fun shopping and snacking at various stalls.

→ Transfer to Haneda Airport to begin our check-in process via Hawaiian Airlines for our flight home.

→ Arrive in Honolulu (same day).
